a case for style

Built-in bookcases can take a basic box of a room and turn it into a jewel. That's the strategy behind the design of this sophisticated office/library. Forget fancy finishes and hand-carved moldings, this room gets its style from simple rectangular shapes repeated as they step around the room. The bookshelves, covered in white oak veneer, not only box in the windows, they repeat their size and shape. Narrower boxes cluster at the room's corners while wide wood bands separate the bookcases and create strong horizontal lines around the room. A bookcase here or there might have made the room feel too busy. These custom-built-ins wrap the room with serene style and storage.
